#### HOME CHURCH QUESTIONS...

1. After reviewing your sermon notes, share what one thought most encouraged you or what one lingering question most puzzles you.

4. Read again about the 2 Witnesses in **11:3-7**. Make two lists... How are you a) similar to them, and b) different to them. Is there any way you could grow to be more like them? If so, are you willing to commit to that?
5. **BONUS QUESTION...** After reading **Revelation 13**, try to come to an understanding of who the two beasts are and what the mark of the beast is.
