3. Read **2 Timothy 2:14-26** A) What verse or idea stands out to you the most? Why? B) Have you ever been involved in an "argument about words"? What was the net effect? C) This passage uses strong terminology to call us to "depart from iniquity" and "cleanse" ourselves so we are useful to God and ready for good works. If you were to actively cleanse yourself from unhealthy uses of technology, how do you think you would be better prepared for God's purposes? Can you think of examples? D) What do you need to "flee" most these days? E) What would pursuing each of the four qualities in v 22 look like in your life? F) Who do you do this with mostly? G) Gentleness or assertiveness – which could you stand to grow more in? H) What parts of this passage suggest the responsibility for our growth is ours? What parts suggest the responsibility is God's? How do you reconcile this tension?
