Beautiful feet? (Isa 52:7; Rom 10:15; Eph 6:15)

Disciple? “Follow, learn and change to become just like...”

OUR METHOD – Baptize (internal) ... Teach to obey (external)

Plunge into transformation? Pickle or dye, not dip

- The Father – love (Rom 8:14-16, 37-39; 1 Jn 3:1)
- Son – grace and truth (Jn 1:14,17; Rom 5:15)
- Holy Spirit – power (Acts 1:8; Eph 3:16; 2 Tim 1:7)

Commands? Radical love for God, others, even enemies!
(Matt 22:34-40; Lk 6:27-36)

5. Read **Luke 10:1-11** in two translations, if possible. A) Why do you think Jesus tells his disciples to pray for workers rather than for people to respond to the message? How does praying this way change a person’s perspective? B) If you were one of these disciples being sent out, what would make you excited about this mission? C) What lessons do you think the disciples learned through this mission? D) In the past, if you’ve been part of a mission that requires God to show up or it fails, what did it feel like and what happened? What did you learn about stepping out that way?

So What?...

6. Eat some pickles (if your host has any) as you unpack your boxes. What fears or concerns hold you back from joining Jesus’ mission and how can the Home Church support you to help you overcome them?
7. If it is appropriate, who can you reach out to this week as a way to “get going and make disciples”?
8. Which of the three areas of being “plunged into transformation” do you most need God to work? What is one clear step you can take this week to invite God to further plunge you into transformation?
9. Take time to pray for each other – for your fears/concerns, those you want to reach out to, and those areas where you need more “plunging into transformation.”
