**The one who endures to the end will be saved.**

-- JESUS, Matthew 10:22/24:13 (NRSV)

**I give them eternal life. They will never die, and no one will snatch them from my hand.**

-- JESUS, John 10:27-29 (CEB)

**If we go on sinning after we have learned the truth, no sacrifice can take away our sins. <sup>27</sup>All that is left is a terrifying wait for judgment and a raging fire that will consume God's enemies.**

**I'm sure about this: the one who started a good work in you will stay with you to complete the job by the day of Christ Jesus.**

**Christ has brought you back to God by dying in his physical body. He did this so that you could come into God's presence without sin, fault, or blame. <sup>23</sup>This is on the condition that you continue in faith.**
