"GIVE" COMMANDS

1. **Love**... God and your neighbour as yourself
2. **Love**... one another like Jesus
3. **Love**... your enemies, like your heavenly Father
4. **Love**... by treating others how you want to be treated
5. **Invest**... wealth in eternal relationships
6. **Radical generosity**... without fanfare
7. **Challenge others**... directly, face to face
8. **Correct others**... humbly; the plank eye process
9. **Lead**... by serving, washing feet like Jesus
10. **Include**... the excluded, make the unpopular your people
11. **Care**... for the least, the last, and the lowest as you would Jesus
12. **Treat strangers like neighbours**... like the Good Samaritan
13. **Teach**... other disciples to obey these commands

Home Church Questions

HANGOUT [Warming Up to the Topic – in one Large Group]

1. Why are you at Home Church?
2. Of the five aspects of the discipleship cycle (Trust, Grow, Give, Go, Together), which do you find most challenging to live out?
3. Did God highlight anything for you from Sunday's teaching? Any lingering questions?

HEAR [Listening to God through Scripture – in Discussion Groups]

4. Read **Luke 16:1-15**.
 - a. What verse or idea seems significant to you?
 - b. The manager has been “wasting” (scattering widely without restraint) money that doesn't belong to him. To what extent do you see yourself in this character? How so?
 - c. Investing our money and possessions in ministry that creates eternal relationships (that is, ministry that leads to more people coming to Christ) is a command of Christ. How seriously should we take this? How seriously do YOU take this?
 - d. Think of verses 10-12 as it relates to your own life and work responsibilities. How is Jesus speaking to you in this passage? Talk about practical next steps for becoming “trustworthy.”
 - e. What do you think “hating” money looks like in the life of a Christ-follower? What are some ways that the love of money keeps you from following Jesus?
 - f. Jesus says, what people value highly is detestable in God's sight. Can you think of some potential examples of this?

HUDDLE [Making It Personal and Praying Together – in Huddles]

5. Review the 13 commands of Christ that help us grow. Which one(s) do you need the most help to grow in this season? Talk about specific things you might do to support one another in this growth.
